This week, Ms. Anjali Gopalan, the Director of the Naz Foundation, Ms. Meena Seshu, the General Secretary of SANGRAM, Ms. Aarti Pai, a member of the National Network of Sex Workers and Shashi Tharoor all met Women and Child Development Minister Maneka Gandhi with a petition regarding the The Trafficking of Persons (Prevention, Protection and Rehabilitation) Bill, 2018, signed by over 4000 sex workers. The petition basically demanded that the law must not target adult consenting sex workers or stop them from carrying out their work, and raised concerns

about the “raid and rescue” model the petition attempts to put in place. We don’t know how the meeting turned out, but everyone in this photo from the meeting looks quite deeply pained.
